Tolbert Street Center ONLY

Televisions	\$12 per television
All other electronics	\$2 per electronic or \$5 unlimited

Acceptable electronics

Computers (as well as parts and cables), laptops, monitors, keyboards, printers, typewriters, stereos, radios, CD players, record players, cell phones, telephones, cameras, camcorders, fax machines, copiers, projectors, VCRs, DVD players, CB radios, circuit boards, UPS/battery backup, network equipment, cables

Unacceptable electronics

Wooden televisions, projector televisions, refrigerators, toaster ovens, washers, dryers, hair dryers, vacuum cleaners, dehumidifiers, humidifiers, power equipment, gas-powered equipment

Tires

Coal Mountain Center ONLY

Tires (no solid tires)	\$3 per tire
Tires on the rim	\$15 per tire

No bills larger than a \$20 bill accepted.

This service is intended for Forsyth County residents and their households. It is not intended for business or commercial tire disposal. Recycling more than six (6) tires per week requires a permit issued by Keep Forsyth County Beautiful or a warning ticket issued by Forsyth County Code Enforcement.

Forsyth County convenience centers will **accept** a variety of recyclables and bagged household trash. **No** yard waste or hazardous materials will be accepted.

- Cash only
- Minimum bag size: none
- Maximum bag size: 32-gallon bag (additional charge for larger bags)
- Most recycling is free of charge
- Trash: \$0.50 per bag for recycling customers
- Trash: \$1.00 per bag for non-recycling customers
- Daily limit for trash: 5 bags (\$2.00 per bag for bags exceeding the daily limit)

Forsyth County convenience centers are designed to be self-serve. If you need help unloading heavy items, please call ahead to ensure the community service workers will be available to help.






Motor Oil

Used motor oil free of gas, water and other chemicals only

Antifreeze

All types of antifreeze

Batteries

Rechargeable batteries

Batteries used in cell phones, laptops, cameras, etc.

Alkaline batteries

Batteries used in flashlights, radios, toys, etc.

Lead acid batteries

Batteries used in automobiles, boats, ATVs, etc.

Paint

Liquid or dried latex-based and oil-based paints and stains in original containers. We do not accept leaking cans.
